## AGE DIVISIONS & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Age Divisions
Bantam (born 1998 and later)
Midget (born 1996 –1997)
Youth (born 1994 –1995)
Intermediate (born 1992–1993)
* Young (born 1990 -1991)
* Athletes who are still 18 through the final day (7/27/08) of the National Junior Olympics Track & Field Championships are eligible to compete.



**Individuals:** Only U.S. citizens, aliens living in the United States, and foreign exchange students are eligible to compete in these Championships. See the USATF rules for more information and exceptions. A competitor must compete in his/her age division only. "Moving up" in any event is prohibited. Competitors in the Bantam and Midget divisions may compete in a maximum of three events, including relays. Competitors in the Youth, Intermediate, and Young divisions may compete in a maximum of four events, including relays. All participating athletes must be registered 2008 members of USATF in good standing.

**Relay Teams:** Only registered 2008 USATF member clubs may enter a relay team(s). All athletes representing a club must be affiliated with and members of that club as part of their USATF membership.

## ENTRY PROCESS:

Individual Entries: **\$7.00** per event      Relay Entries: **\$28.00** per relay team

The Youth Chairs of each USATF Association in the region (Southern California, Nevada and San Diego-Imperial Association) are responsible for entering their athletes by submitting their Hy-Tek Entry Data Back File no later than **Sunday, June 15, 2008**. Additional separate information will be provided to the youth chairs regarding entry information and fees.

**Entry Forms:** The Youth Chairs or designee of each USATF Association shall be responsible for ensuring all entry forms are complete and the date of birth of each athlete has been verified prior to competing in the Regional Championships.

**Advancement:** The top three individuals and relay teams in each event of each division will advance to the National Junior Olympics Championships to be held at Burke High School in Omaha, Nebraska held July 22, 2008 - July 27, 2008. All advancement/entry forms and National Junior Olympic Championships fees shall be processed by the conclusion of the final day of competition. Each Youth Chair or his/her designated processor shall be responsible for processing all advancement/entry forms and ensuring all fees are collected.

**Packet Pick Up:** Packet pick-up will be available at San Diego State University and Escondido High School.

**Awards:** USATF Junior Olympic medals will be awarded to the top three athletes in individual events in all divisions. The top three relay teams in all divisions will be awarded medals in all divisions.

**Coaches Meeting:** A coach meeting will be held on Saturday, June 21, 2008 at 7:45 AM.

**Event Check-In:** Athletes participating in a track event must check in with the Clerk of the Course. Athletes competing in a field event should report directly to the event for check in. Athletes will be expected to check-in with their assigned bid number.

**Competition Bid Numbers:** All competitors must wear their assigned bib numbers during competition and on the front on their jerseys only. Bid Numbers will be placed in team or unattached athlete packets. Bid numbers will be reviewed at the clerk and field events areas. The replacement cost for a lost bid(s) is **\$7** payable by cash only to meet management.

**Event Results:** During competition, event results will be posted. In addition, event results will be posted at [www.sdusatf.org](http://www.sdusatf.org).

**Protests:** There will be a **\$60.00 cash only** fee for all protests. Protests must be submitted to the Meet Referee at once and not later than 30 minutes after a result has been announced or published. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

**RULES – CONDUCT & FACILITY:** USATF Rules will apply at this competition.

All athletes and spectators are expected to abide by rules as established by San Diego State University and the Escondido Union High School District. Smoking and alcohol is prohibited on school grounds. No pets or animals will be allowed on school premises. Additionally, the following will apply:

- Coaches are not permitted on the track infield except by permission of the Meet Director or designee.
- Athletes must warm up in the designated warm-up area.
- Canopies must be secured and are limited to the top portion of stadium seating. Large umbrellas may not be used in the mid and lower areas of stadium seating as they impede spectator's views.
- Profane language, aggressive behavior or actions deemed not sportsmanlike, or in keeping with a youth friendly environment is prohibited.

Failure to comply with rules may result in athlete disqualification and athlete or spectator dismissal from the premises.

**Event Merchandise:** Commemorative clothing (Tee Shirts, shirts, etc.) will be available for purchase.

**Concession:** Concessions will be made available.

**Vendors:** All vendors must be approved by the Meet Director. Persons desirous of providing a service or good at this event must contact the meet director at [youth@sdusatf.org](mailto:youth@sdusatf.org).

**Parking: San Diego State University:** Underground parking is available for a fee of \$1 per hour. **Escondido High School:** Parking is available. Bus and mobile home parking is limited. These vehicles must park in designated areas only. Parking will be strictly enforced. Violators will be subject to ticketing or tow with or without warning.

- **Javelin has the surface run-up which extends on the track for longer run-up**
- **Steeplechase has an inside track water jump**
- **4 long jump pits; 2 pits will be used simultaneously for each division**
- **3/16 pyramid spikes only will be permitted track and Long Jump Pits areas**
- **¼ pyramid spikes permitted for the High Jump**
- **¼ pyramid spikes permitted for the Javelin.**
- **Any marks (tape) must be removed immediately following competition**
- **Spike requirements will be strictly enforced**
